COURSE ABSTRACT

The course is intended for students who begin the acquisition of the Russian language as a Foreign Language without previous knowledge.

The goal of the course is to develop the communicative competencies of students.

The aims of the course are as follows:

- development of the reading, listening and writing skills which correspond to the level A1 (beginners);
- correction of pronunciation;
- broadening of the lexical minimum;
- acquisition of the grammatical patterns of the Russian language.

The content of the course is worked out in accordance with demands of the EU language politics.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Successfully mastering the course, students know the lexical minimum in the frames of the programme. Moreover, students get the understanding about the grammatical system of the Russian language.

Students acquire reading, writing, speaking and listening skills in Russian language on the A1 level.
