COURSE ABSTRACT

The course will be devoted to developing various legal skills necessary in everyday work of practicing lawyers. One of the principal elements of the course will be for students to learn to draft the most widely used legal documents and receive practical feedback on their work. In order to prepare legal documents students will have to extensively apply legal research skills and navigate through Latvian and international legal landscape. During the course students will also receive practical guidance in selecting legal materials and arguments, as well as fine-tuning their position to best suit the interests of clients and present their ideas clearly and persuasively.
