### **COURSE ABSTRACT**

The Risk Management course is designed to develop key risk management competencies that are essential within corporate and business environments. The course provides an overview of how risk management frameworks work in practice and what challenges in managing the risk the companies are facing. The course will focus to non-financial risk area mainly.
